Fall is here! It's time to rake 'em up!

Raking or blowing leaves from your yard into the street is not permitted by City Code. The street sweeper is not able to sweep up large piles of leaves at the curb, and leaves left in the street can cause clogged catch basins, slippery surfaces and rotten vegetation. After raking or blowing leaves into piles, there are several ways to dispose of them:

Mulch leaves with a lawnmower and spread the mixture over flowerbeds for winter. The nutrients in leaves are beneficial.

Garbage Service - Place the leaves in your garbage can. Be careful not to exceed the weight limit. Your garbage collector can pick up bags of leaves for an additional charge.

Check with your garbage service if you have questions.

Burning - Contact the Estacada Rural Fire District to obtain a burning permit (no charge) 503-630-7712

Compost the leaves.
